## 2011 Tennis Format

### Rounds / Segments / Games

- Each team will play 3 rounds against 3 different teams
- Each round will consist of two 20 minutes segments for a total of 40 minutes
- Each segment will consist of a maximum of 8 games
- Segment 1: (20 minutes)
  - Men vs. Men on one court (max 8 games)
  - Women vs. Women on adjacent court (max 8 games)
- Segment 2: (20 minutes)
  - Mixed doubles on both courts (max 8 games each court)
  - Players may be freely substituted during play between points, however:
    - There must always be one man and one woman playing, and
    - Alternate serving between man and woman must be maintained

### Team Scoring

- During one segment a team can play up to 8 games per court
- If less than 8 games were played on a court, a coin toss will determine the winner of the remaining games.
- The total number of games won on each court in each segment is the team score for the round (total wins out of 32 games)
- The team's score for the day will be total wins in all three rounds (total wins out of 96 games)

### General Play

- No-Ad scoring will be used throughout
- The end of a segment is indicated by a horn blowing – the current game may be finished
- The tennis balls belong to the court – so please leave them there when you leave
- Mulligans may be used during play:
  - Each team may use one mulligan per game
  - It can be used to replay any point
  - Teams and individuals may purchase 'Mulligan Cards' at the event
  - A player using a mulligan must present the card to opposing team who will tear up the card signifying its use.
